

Personal Data Request – Instructions & Explanation

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Introduction

As a “data subject”, you have certain rights under European law to control the collection and use (the “processing”) of information about you (your “personal data”) by the entity responsible for that processing (the “data controller”). These rights include the right to **access** your personal data being processed, to request **rectification** or **erasure** of your personal data, to **restrict** the processing of your personal data, and to **object** to the processing of your personal data. These rights are not absolute and may be subject to limitations, depending on specific circumstances.

If your personal data has been processed by a data controller within the Maersk Drilling group of companies (referred to herein generally and collectively and “Maersk Drilling”), you may submit a personal data request to exercise your rights as a data subject.

Maersk Drilling provides this Personal Data Request Form (the “Request Form”) to aid and streamline the submission of personal data requests. It is not mandatory to use this Request Form to submit a personal data request to Maersk Drilling, however use of this Request Form will enable to Maersk Drilling to respond more swiftly to your request.

Frequently Asked Questions

<i>Am I a Maersk Drilling data subject?</i>	You are a Maersk Drilling data subject if your personal data (i.e. information that can identify you) has been processed by Maersk Drilling, e.g. in the course of administration of an employment relationship with Maersk Drilling.
<i>Where can I find a copy of the Maersk Drilling employee privacy statement?</i>	The Maersk Drilling employee Privacy Statement is available on the Maersk Drilling internal intranet. If you do not have access to the intranet or cannot locate the privacy statement, please contact PRIVACY@maerskdirilling.com to request a copy.
<i>What happens if I request access?</i>	<p>If you make an access request, Maersk Drilling will provide you with the personal data about you that we have recorded in our internal systems and with information about how and why we process your personal data.</p> <p>The right of access is not absolute and is subject to some exceptions. Maersk Drilling is not obligated to provide access to your personal data if your interest in accessing that data is considered subordinate to other competing compelling interests, including e.g.:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Maersk Drilling’s interest in maintaining confidentiality of its or a business partner’s (1) current or potential commercial and contractual relationships, (2) trade secrets, and/or (3) intellectual property rights; • Matters that are relevant for the competitiveness of Maersk Drilling; • Your or other data subjects’ fundamental rights and freedoms; • The pursuit, defense, or enforcement of civil claims by Maersk Drilling; • Ongoing internal or regulatory investigations into allegations of law or Maersk Drilling company policy. <p>Application of such exceptions will be assessed on a case-by-case basis. If one of these exceptions apply, Maersk Drilling will explain to you what the exception is and why it applies to your request.</p>

<p><i>What happens if I ask for rectification?</i></p>	<p>A request for rectification is a request to correct personal data about you that is recorded in our systems and that is demonstrated to be inaccurate. In order for us to appropriately assess your request for rectification, you will need to provide details about what personal data you believe to be incorrect and why. If, upon review, your request for rectification is determined to be justified, we will rectify the noted inaccuracies.</p>
<p><i>What happens if I ask for erasure (“the right to be forgotten”)?</i></p>	<p>A request for erasure is a request to erase or delete personal data about you that is recorded in our systems. In order for us to appropriately assess your request for erasure, you will need to provide details about what personal data you wish to be deleted.</p> <p>The right to erasure is not absolute, which means that Maersk Drilling may be entitled to continue to process your personal data even though you wish for it to be deleted. Each request will be considered on a case-by-case basis.</p> <p>When Maersk Drilling replies to your request, we will inform you whether we can comply with your request for erasure and why.</p>
<p><i>What happens if I ask for restriction?</i></p>	<p>A request for restriction is a request for Maersk Drilling to limit the ways or manner in which we process your personal data. In order for us to appropriately assess your request for restriction, you will need to provide details about what personal data you wish to restrict processing of, how you wish to restrict that processing, and why.</p> <p>The right to restriction is not absolute, which means that Maersk Drilling may be entitled to continue to process your personal data even though you wish for us to limit our processing. Each request will be considered on a case-by-case basis.</p> <p>When Maersk Drilling replies to your request, we will inform you whether we believe your request for restriction is justified, and if so, how we will process your personal data in the future.</p>
<p><i>What happens if I object?</i></p>	<p>If you object to the processing of your personal data, you indicate your belief that the circumstances of your particular situation are such that your interests or fundamental rights and freedoms override Maersk Drilling’s legitimate interests in processing your data and that Maersk Drilling should abstain from further processing of your data.</p> <p>When Maersk Drilling responds to your objection, we will inform you whether we consider your objection is justified. If it is justified, Maersk Drilling may no longer process your personal data. However, if Maersk Drilling has compelling legitimate grounds to continue the processing, we will inform you of these.</p>

Maersk Drilling must confirm your identity prior to processing a personal data request (see Section 2 of the Request Form). If you are a current Maersk Drilling employee, we suggest that you make this submission from your personal Maersk Drilling email address (e.g. firstname.lastname@maerskdirilling.com), as this will assist us to confirm your identity.
